Brit Milah

Since the time of our Patriarch Abraham, Jews have observed circumcision as the sign of our covenant with G-d. More than any other ritual, *Brit Milah* (circumcision) is the ultimate affirmation of Jewish identity. Abraham was circumcised at the age of ninety-nine, indicating that every Jewish male, regardless of age, can and should observe this commandment.

According to *Kabbalah*, there are three parts to the soul. A man is born with one portion, at his *Brit* he receives a second part, and at his *Bar Mitzvah* he gains the final third. In addition to being enhanced by his *Neshamah* (soul), at his *Brit* he is also given his Hebrew name.

This Mitzvah, carved into one's very flesh, is the only Mitzvah that a man carries with him every moment of his life. Even during periods of persecution and great personal risk, wherever we dwell, we observe this Mitzvah, because it is a personal sign of G-d's sovereignty, and therefore essential for Jewish continuity.

Besides the medical benefits accrued by doing it on the eighth day, a *Brit* (or "Bris" in Ashkenazi pronunciation), should be performed as G-d commanded us, on the eighth day, by a proper observant *Mohel*.

"This is My covenant that you shall observe between Me and you and your children after you, to circumcise your every male"

(Genesis 17:1)
