The individual that you select must be experienced with the use of an Iz'mil (surgical blade) and shield only.



## Frequently Asked Questions



How do I find a qualified Mohel or know if the person performing the circumcision uses a clamp?

When do you perform a circumcision, and when should it be postponed?

Circumcision is performed on the 8th day only on a healthy baby. If baby is underweight, pre-mature or yellow (jaundiced), circumcision must be postponed. Please contact us for specific cases.

What should I do if my child was circumcised using a clamp?

A circumcision performed with a clamp is considered not valid and not according to Jewish law. Former Chief Rabbi of Israel Rabbi Mordechai Eliyahu along with other Rabbinical authorites have stated that "There should be drawing of the blood" (Hatafat Dom Brit) to correct pervious circumcision.
