



Methods of Circumcision

1. Mogen Clamp



2. Gomco Clamp



Mogen and Gomco clamps:

- * Are not safe according to FDA (Food & Drug Administration) reports and have led to various patient injuries (laceration, penile amputation, excessive foreskin removal, and urethral damage).
- * Are extremely painful.
- * Cause increase of infant heart rate and total crying time.
- * Not considered kosher (valid) by Jewish law.

3. Traditional Jewish Shield



and Iz'mil (surgical blade)



Traditional Jewish Shield and Iz'mil

- * Foreskin is cut "NOT CRUSHED" resulting in no pain.
- * Healing time is 24 hours.
- * Circumcision takes seconds.
- * Baby cries less.
- * Kosher and according to Jewish law.
